Apiwat Ratanawaraha is Associate Professor at the Department of Urban and Regional Planning and the Deputy Director of the Center for Science, Technology, and Society at Chulalongkorn University in Bangkok. A recipient of Thailand's National Outstanding Researcher Award (Philosophy) in 2021, Apiwat's current research focuses on urban transitions, with topics including the futures of urban life, globalization of land, informal urban mobility, and citizen science. He has served in several sub-committees of the Thai Parliament, Thailand Consumers Council, and various research councils. His recent books include "The Thai Urbanization," "The Land Economy of Thailand" and "The Futures of Thailand 2042." Previously a visiting assistant professor at the MIT Department of Urban Studies and Planning and a visiting scholar at the Harvard-Yenching Institute, he is currently a Visiting Research Scholar at the Center for Southeast Asian Studies at Kyoto University. He has been a Full Member of the Club of Rome since 2020. He received B.Eng. from the University of Tokyo, M.Phil. from the University of Cambridge, and M.C.P and Ph.D. from MIT.
